

KOLKATA PORT TRUST

1. Kolkata Port Trust intends to recruit 06 (six) Trainee Pilots for which applications are invited from candidates in possession of any of the following certificate of competencies issued by the Director General of Shipping, Government of India.

- a. Master (FG)/Dredge Master Gr.I or equivalent.
- b. 1st Mate's (FG)/Dredge Master- Gr.II
- c. 2nd Mate's (FG)/Dredge Mate - Gr.I
- d. B.Sc. Nautical Science

2. The candidates will join as Trainee Pilots and on successful completion of the prescribed training scheme, they would be adjusted against regular vacancies of Pilots in the scale of pay of Rs. 29,100-54,500/- (provisional, subject to final decision of Ministry of Shipping and is under revision). Candidates in possession of Master (FG) Certificate/Dredge Master-Grade-I or equivalent certificates would directly join at the bottom of pilot's scale of pay i.e. Rs. 29,100-54,500/- (provisional, subject to final decision of Ministry of Shipping and is under revision).

The trainee Pilots would be posted at Kolkata or at Haldia subject to administrative convenience. However, they would finally be trained for both Kolkata and Haldia channels.

The incumbents in addition to their emoluments will also be entitled to HRA, Cafeteria, LTC, Leave Encashment, Gratuity, Provident Fund, Medical facilities for self and family, Uniform making and washing allowances. During the training period the incumbents will be paid monthly salary depending on entry qualifications which are as follows:

B.Sc. Nautical Science	Will start at the basic pay of Rs. 20,600/-	52 months which includes passing of Functions I & III of 2 nd Mates (FG) & Functions I & III of 1 st Mate (FG) Examinations.

Adjustment in higher stage is subject to passing of requisite examinations. Each candidate shall be allowed a maximum of 3 attempts to pass each of the examination failing which, his services are liable to be terminated.

3. **Number of vacancies - 06 [UR-3,SC-3]**

4. **AGE LIMIT : As on 1.09.2018.** (a) Not exceeding 25 years for B.Sc Nautical Science (b) Not exceeding 30 years in case of candidates possessing 2nd Mates (FG)/1st Mate (FG)/Dredge Master- Gr. II/Dredge Mate-Gr.-I (c) Not exceeding 35 years for Master (FG) candidates/Dredge Master-Gr I .

5. The age limit will be relaxable by 5 years for SC candidates. The post is not suitable for PWD category (OH/HH/VH).

6. The selected candidates will be required to execute a BOND prior to joining that they would serve the Port for a period of at least 5 years after qualifying as a Pilot, failing which, they will have to pay KoPT an amount equivalent to 6 months' salary together with the cost of training as may be determined by the appointing authority.
