Reservation

The Provision of ORV Act 1975 and Rules made there under and such other principles of reservation as prescribed by the State Government from time to time shall be followed.

- 1. The engagement of all Sikshya Sahayak will be made by the Collector under each category i.e. Trained Graduate Science, Trained Graduate Arts (Social Science), Trained Graduate Arts (Language) under the Programme of Sarva Sikshya Abhiyan (SSA) and for the implementation of the said Act. TGT Science will mean TGT (Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics) or TGT (CBZ/ Life Science), TGT (Social Science) will mean TGT Arts having any two of the optional subject such as History, Geography, Political Science and Economics & TGT (language) will mean TGT Arts having Odia or English as one of the optional subjects.
- 2. Provided that, relaxation of 5% in minimum qualifying marks in Higher Secondary (+2) or in graduation level, as the case may be shall be allowed to the candidates belonging to SC, ST, OBC/ SEBC Category.
- 3. Provided that, if trained candidates having the above percentage of marks in graduation level are not available and posts remained unfilled, trained candidates having the minimum percentage of marks prescribed at the time of admission in teacher education course with OTET pass shall also be considered for engagement.
- 4. For the purpose of degree in teacher education (B.Ed) BEd degree of other Universities declared equivalent with corresponding degree of the Universities of Odisha and a course recognized by the NCTE shall be considered.
- 5. Candidates who are in employment shall furnish the copy of the No objection certificate issued by the employer.

(b) AGE

Candidates shall not be below 18 years and above 35 years of age as on 01.01.2018. In case of SC/ST/Women/Ex-Servicemen & SEBC Candidates the upper age limit may be relaxed by 5 (Five) years and in case of PH candidate the upper age limit may be relaxed by 10 years.

2. Selection Procedure:

- a. The Sikshya Sahayak will be engaged by the Selection Committee to be headed by the Collector, PD DRDA, C.I. of School (SSD), D.I. of School (SSD), District Welfare Officer, District Employment Officer and the District Project Co-ordinator (SSA). The District Welfare Officer will act as Convener of the Committee who shall prepare the draft selection list and place the same before the Committee for approval. The draft selection list will be put up in the notice board inviting objections if any. After 15 days from the date of such publication and after considering the claims and objections if any, the final selection list will be notified.
- b. Selection shall be made only on merit i.e. on the basis of percentage of marks as noted below.
- (i) The marks secured in 4th optional or extra optional subject in HSC examination/ Higher Secondary (+2) Examination is to be deducted from the total marks for arriving at the effective percentage of marks.
- (ii) In case of compartmental examination the fail marks secured in the subject (s) is to be deducted from the total marks and pass marks of the compartmental examination shall be added to the total marks for arriving at the effective percentage of marks.
- (iii) In case of candidates having qualification of graduation with BEd the percentage of marks secured by the candidates in HSC examination + percentage of marks secured by the candidates in Pass/Hons subject + percentage of marks secured in the BEd/ Special BEd examination shall be considered.
- (iv) In case two or more candidates secure the same marks, the candidates older in age and if ages are same, the candidates passing High School Certificates Examination earlier will be placed above the other in the selection list.
- (v) The selection list will be calid for a period of one year from the date of its final publication.
- (vi) The engagement will be on an annual contractual basis, Contract will be renewed in subsequent years depending on the performance of the candidate. The Sikshya Sahayak can be removed from engagement with a prior notice of 30 days, if he/she violates the conditions of the contract or on the basis of adverse report of the School Management Committee/ SMDC i.e. on unauthorized absence/ Misconduct/ Involvement in criminal cases.
